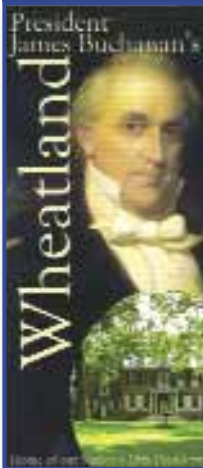

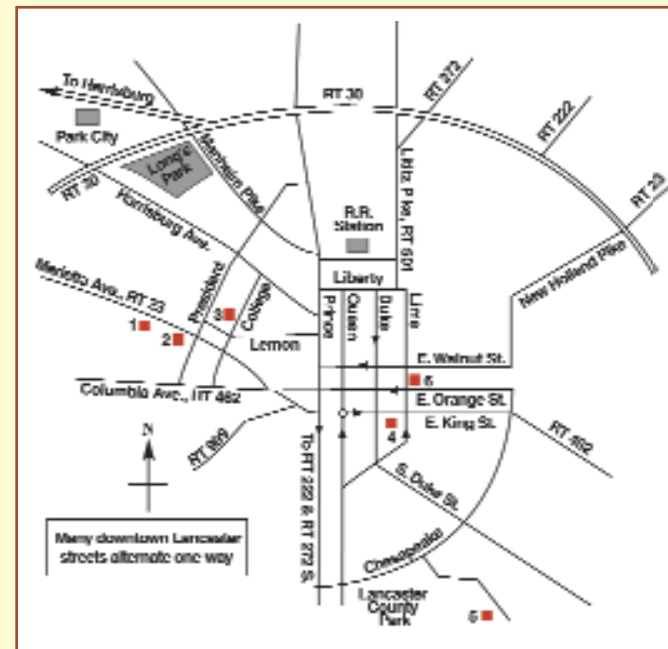

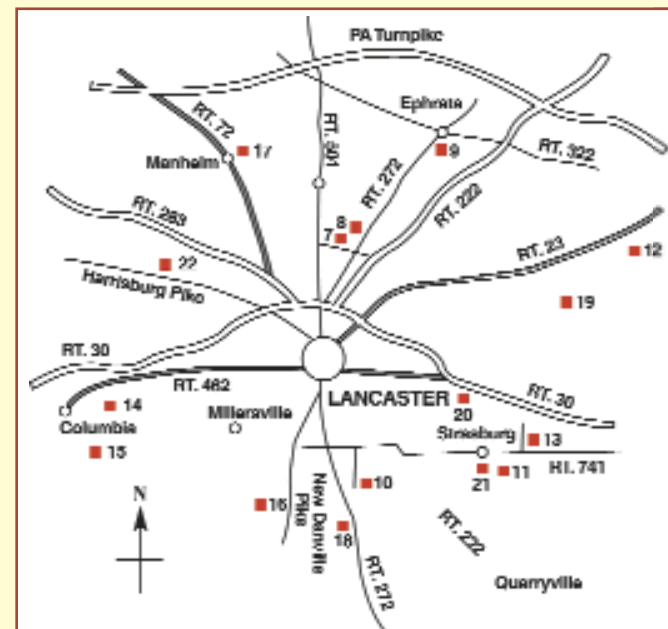

The Society specializes in Manheim and Manheim area history, artifacts and genealogy and boasts a renovated train station which houses a transportation and Industry museum and maintains a working Birney Trolley. \$EGHMPRS
